(PAC) has announced the release of IDecode® Version 4.01, the firm's driver's license parsing software which offers the most user-friendly and reliable ability to acquire and update the capacity to capture the data on US state and Canadian provincial driver's ID's, as well as military ID cards and leading credit cards.

Included in the V.4.01 update is the capacity to handle one new U.S. territory, American Samoa which just recently started issuing a 2D bar coded driver's license.
